
IT WENT WELL

On April 28, the U.S. Supreme Court heard arguments regarding: 1) whether same-sex couples are guaranteed the right to marry by the U.S. Constitution. 2) whether states that don't recognize same-sex marriages are required by the Constitution to recognize those marriages when they've been performed in a state where they are legal. The cases were consolidated for two-and-a-half hours of oral arguments. A decision will be made at the end of June before the Supreme Court adjourns for the summer.
