- 1. Identify and describe an ethical issue that impacts LGBT people
- 2. Describe specifically who is impacted and the significance of this ethical issue. Who are the stakeholders?
- 3. Describe the ethical principles involved in this situation/issue.
- 4. Propose solutions or responses to the situation, if any.
